



Rekindle Youth is a project administered by The Rewild Project with funding in place to codevelop a qualification in Heritage Crafts and Land Based Skills (CALS) over the 22-23 academic year.

Our aim is to work with young people aged 13-18 who are not thriving in the current education system, to reignite their passion for life and the future.

AIMS:

- To build resilience in our young people, a connection to nature and to themselves.
- To develop a range of useful practical, and transferable skills meeting and learning from some inspiring local craftspeople.
- To provide a complete holistic rewilding experience setting them in good stead for the future.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- 1. Develop a range of craft skills and future career options.
- 2. Develop emotional intelligence and resilience.
- 3. Feel more comfortable spending time out in nature.
- 4. Have a range of navigational skills and woodcraft tools.
- 5. Be able to recognise and name a range of wild herbs and plants along with benefits or risks.
- 6. Feel comfortable with using knives for bushcraft and ancestral skills and know how to use safety and what to do in an emergency.
- 7. Know what ancestral skills are and why they are still important.
