My Responsibilities

- To provide services as described in the sample packages section, to the best of my ability within the scope of my experience and skills.
- I am not a medical professional and do not take clinical responsibility for you or your baby.
- During the 'on-call' period from 37 weeks onwards I will let you know if I need to travel out of area for any reason. I can work with a back-up doula to ensure that you are still supported.
- Sometimes I may have dates booked prior to our contract and I will let you know these at the time of booking.
- If there are any family emergencies or other rare situations where I travel out of area, I will do my best to arrange cover and to keep you fully aware.





- My role is to support you throughout the birth. I will always listen to you and your wishes, which may change as the labour and birth progresses. Each woman and each birth is individual. I can remind you of your preferences, but I am not here to guarantee a certain kind of birth, or to put pressure on you.
- I will build rapport with any other supporters in the birth space, to create a calm, loving, and conducive birthing environment.

<u>Your Responsibilities</u>


- To call me when you think labour is starting day or night.
- To let me know about early signs of labour: such as a show, aches, pains, tightening's, waters leaking etc...
- Honesty:- about your pregnancy and early labour symptoms; any symptoms you are experiencing.
- To pay the agreed amount/s on time.

What if I do not make the birth?

- I will make every effort to provide the services described in this contract arriving with you in accordance with the terms of the package 1.5-2.5 hours from your callout to me (by telephone).
- It may be that external circumstances happen (for example rapid labour or some travel problem).
- If failure to attend your birth is due to <u>my misjudgement or unavailability</u>, the birth attendance part of the contract will be deducted, unless my back-up doulas attends the birth instead.
- But, if it is due to circumstances beyond anyone's control or mistake on your part (e.g. you call me too late or choose to keep vital information from me) the full fee applies.

Cancellations

- If you decide to cancel this contract less than six weeks before your due date, the full fee applies.
- Cancellations 6-12 weeks before the birth 50% is due.
- 12 weeks before birth Full refund minus \pm 200 cancellation fee.
